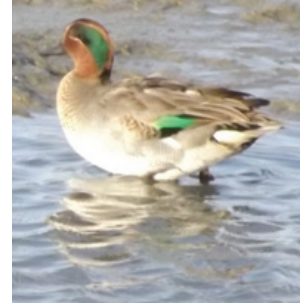

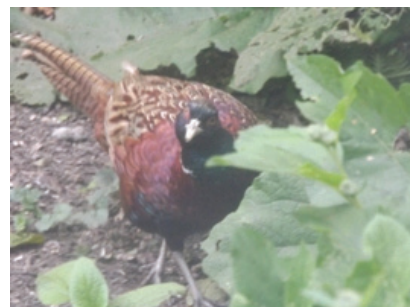
Tufted Duck

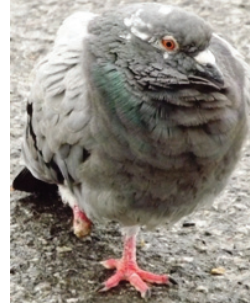
Common Tern

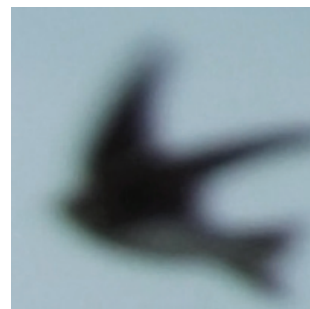
Great Spotted Woodpecker

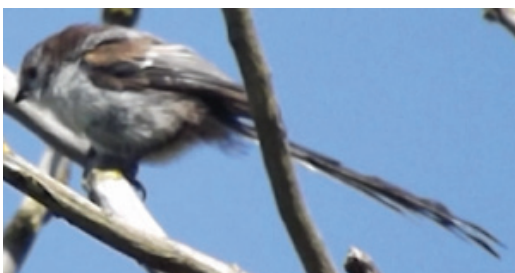

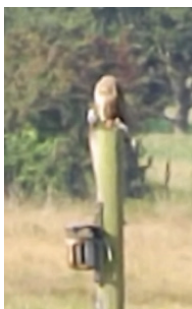
